Short description	<p>The IRA programme is designed for distinguished researchers from Poland or abroad with recognized research achievements whose experience will ensure the effective functioning of the unit implementing the IRA. Applicants should, if possible, represent the level of ERC Advanced Grant scientists and have profiles in line with those of applicants for directorial positions in leading scientific institutes in the world. The grant should lead to the creation of highly specialized, world-class research centers in Poland which apply the best international practices with regards to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HR policy -R&D management -Commercialisation of R&D results. <p>One of the IRA Unit's authorities is International Scientific Committee. At least half of the ISC members must have their primary place of employment outside Poland. Financed by IRA may be Research Teams' Leaders, who have been chosen in international competition by ISC. Research Team Leader launches the recruitment procedure for research team's members through students, postgraduate students and PhDs. Research activities at the Unit are carried out by research teams headed by their respective leaders as well as independent researchers.</p>
