List of ongoing COST Actions: <a href="http://www.cost.eu/COST_Actions">http://www.cost.eu/COST_Actions</a></p> <p><b>COST Actions</b> are a flexible, fast, effective and efficient networking instrument for researchers, engineers and scholars to cooperate and coordinate nationally funded research activities. <b>COST Actions allow European researchers to jointly develop their own ideas in any science and technology field.</b>  <b>COST Actions</b> are bottom-up <b>science and technology networks, open to researchers and stakeholders</b> with a duration of <b>four years</b>. They are active through a range of <a href="#">networking tools</a>, such as <b>workshops, conferences, training schools, short-term scientific missions (STSMs), and dissemination activities.</b>  <b>COST does not fund research itself.</b>  <b>Mobility costs (travel costs)</b> of researchers participating in a specific COST actions are being reimbursed directly to the researchers or to the research institutions represented.</p>
