Short description	<p>Opportunity to employ and fund Research activities in European research institutions active in the field of Jewish studies.</p> <p>Post-Doctoral Fellowship: Grants of up to £35,000 per annum are available for European institutions to employ a post-doctoral fellow (up to 5 years after PhD award before call deadline). Candidates researching and/or teaching any topic within the field of Jewish Studies will be considered eligible for funding; <u>additionally</u>, the Foundation particularly welcomes applications from those engaged in the study of contemporary Jewish life in Europe from a social science perspective or those whose proposals involve digital humanities research techniques.</p> <p>Applications must be submitted by the Head of Department or the principal investigator at the institution where the post-doctoral fellow will be employed. Institutions may only support a single post-doctoral fellowship application.</p> <p>Doctoral Fellowship: Individual students entering their first year of doctoral study can apply for grants of up to £17,000 per year for up to three years to prepare and complete their doctoral dissertation in Jewish studies at an academic institution in Europe. Students in later years of a doctoral programme may also apply, but their proposed period of funding will be expected to be shorter. Additional eligibility criteria: individuals of EU citizens or citizens of another European non-EU member country (Albania, Belarus, Gibraltar, Iceland, Lichtenstein, Macedonia, Montenegro, Norway, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, and Russia).</p>
