Short description	<p>SONATINA is a funding scheme addressed to researchers at the onset of their career offering them full-time employment in Polish research institutions and funding to carry out research projects, as well as the opportunity of a 3-6-month visiting fellowship outside of Poland</p> <p><u>Principal Investigator</u>: a researcher within 3 years of receiving his or her PhD degree or who will obtain a PhD degree on the 30th of June of the year referred to in the call documentation</p> <p>Project duration: 24 or 36 months</p> <p>Funding: Researchers may apply for funding of costs relevant necessary and directly connected to the proposed research, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Personnel •Consumables •Travel and subsistence costs of the fellowship outside of Poland •Outsourcing •Other: publication costs, collective investigators, devices and software, etc. •Overheads: up to 40% <p>SONATINA applicants may not seek funding for research equipment</p> <p>Application: short project description must be written in Polish, full project description must be provided in English</p>
