<b>Short description</b>	<p><b>Goal:</b> Creation and participation in international joint research and innovation training <b>networks</b> focused on selected <b>research</b> topic, and/or <b>doctoral programmes</b>; Involve multinational research teams from <b>academia and outside</b>. Participating institutions (from at least 3 different EU or associated countries (with H2020 programme) <b>employ Early-Stage-Researchers (ESR) for 3-36 months</b> to work on the project goals (research training activities). Additional participants from any organisation anywhere in the world can also join a network.</p> <p>Institutions participating in the projects may organize <b>conferences, summer schools and dedicated courses</b> open also for researchers from institutions not formally involved in the project (outside project consortium).</p> <p><b>Project duration:</b> up to 4 years</p> <p><u>Detailed information about 3 types of ITN's projects:</u></p> <p><b>European Training Networks (ETN)</b>  ETNs aims at running joint research and innovation training <b>networks for doctoral students</b> focused on selected <b>research</b> topic by at least 3 different institutions from 3 different EU or associated countries (with H2020 programme) from <b>academia and outside</b> (businesses, SMEs, socio-economic actors, NGOs),</p> <p><b>European Industrial Doctorates (EID):</b>  EID aim at <b>joint doctoral training</b> delivered by <b>at least one academic partner</b> entitled to award doctoral degrees, <b>and at least one partner from outside academia</b>, primarily enterprise. Each participating researcher is enrolled in a doctoral programme and is jointly supervised by supervisors from the academic and non-academic sector, where they spend at least 50% of their time.</p> <p><b>The aim</b> is for the doctoral candidates to <b>develop skills inside and outside academia</b> that respond to public and private sector needs.</p> <p>The organisations should be established in <b>at least two different EU or associated countries</b>. A wider set of partner organisations from anywhere in the world may also complement the training, and about</p> <p><b>European Joint Doctorates (EJD):</b>  A minimum of <b>three academic organisations</b> form a network with the aim of <b>delivering joint, double or multiple degrees</b>. Joint supervision of the</p>

	<p>research fellow and a joint governance structure are mandatory.</p> <p><b>The aim</b> is to promote <b>international, intersectoral and multi/interdisciplinary collaboration in doctoral training in Europe.</b></p> <p>The organisations should be from different <a href="#">EU or associated countries</a>.
